To Whom It May Concern:

On Friday June, 2022 I again received a call from Christina, an employee of Miriam's Kitchen, regarding housing approval for supportive services housing. This was followed up by a return conversation Monday June 6, 2022 where she requested my address to mail a document for me to sign stating that I was declining supportive service housing. Christina re-assured me she would include the statement this was conditional on the fact that I NEVER want assistive care/companion services delivered via a residential setting. These assistive care services are only to be delivered via an assisted living facility, and companion care NEVER delivered. I ended the conversation stating that I would remit the signed letter to both DHS and their organizationt. Upon receipt Monday June 13, 2022 without this clarified, I've added this and am remitting a copy to your department. If there is a reason that these services are to be provided that I'm unaware of, I need additional information, and will change my response accordingly. Furthermore, I do NOT want any type of intermediary involved in order to circumvent this decision. Should I require assistive services in the future I will contact DHS in writing for their provision, which I will have provided at an assisted living facility. Feel free to contact me if this needs clarification, in writing please. Otherwise, I will consider this matter closed with DC Medicaid as my only insurance and no additional supportive services provided.
