This letter is in response to your VM received this date regarding continuation on case management services. As stated previously I am still waiting for housing assistance. As stated previously I am uninterested in rapid rehousing as this will not resolve my long term housing issue. Therefore a HUD voucher would be a better fit. As discussed at our last inter-action I had contacted DC housing and they were only dealing with emergency issues for current recipients. As the city is still requesting work at home I'm assuming this is still the case. I was given a list of HUD properties at the intake update Jan 27, 2021. I have contacted properties in the vicinity of work. Several have not had vacancies in years. Several were not accepting waiting list applications. Many did not return calls to VM. One just had an open house and would not be accepting applications for a year. I will follow up monthly with properties where it is applicable.

Regarding work.

I am working 15-18 hours a week as this allows me to keep DC Medicaid as my only insurance provider. (Which is what I want) As stated previously under No circumstances do I want any type of assistive/supervisory services requested or provided.

Therefore, I do request case management regarding Housing. I do not want any other type of service requested. I also request that I am provided with any pertinent information regarding how this is resolved.
